Prior to that time only a small percent of people could trace their ancestry three generations and many who could were possessed of false ideas as to the numbers and standing of the original name. So frequently was this the case that those desiring to record the early history of any line, met with considerable difficulty in extracting authentic data from the colonists; the former avowing that the latter was seeking to secure their share in the supposed glistening fortune across the ocean. These traditional ghosts are now seldom met with. The genealogist is better understood, though...
